Paybacks: 70% on most classes

Helmets: required for anyone under 19 years of age

***Pony Classes:** height less than 58" or 14.2 hands

****Restricted Classes:** exhibitor can't cross enter into a
canter class in the same division

Mandatory Signature: for release of liability & pictures

Beginner Classes: are for riders who have been riding less
than 2 yrs, OR ride exclusively in a lesson program and
do not own their own horse. W/T riders can't cross-
enter Beginner W/T/C classes & W/T/C riders can't
cross-enter any W/T Beginner classes.

Show Information

- 8 AM: show day start time at the Hoosier Horse Park: 105 S. Kern St. Nineveh, IN 46164
- Afternoon sessions will not begin before 11:00 am
- Use Edinburgh zip code 46124 for GPS
- Entry forms available on website: indianasaddlehorse.org. Submit online, or print out & mail entry forms to Show Secretary Lisa Colles, 807 N. Broadway, Greenfield, IN 46140, 7 days prior to show date.
- Show day entries are accepted.
- Class entries close 4 classes prior to the class currently in the show ring.
- First 4 classes of the morning sessions must be entered by 7:30 AM day of show.
- 2 Minute Gate Call strictly enforced (you must be in the show ring within 2 minutes of class announcement).
- Tack Holds: contact the in-gate keeper for tack holds (Maximum 5 minutes)
- Signature mandatory for release of liability & pictures taken at & during the show.
- Helmets required for anyone under 19 years of age Shirts, long pants and boots are required to show.
- A" Helper" is required in the ring & line-up for **Restricted class #s 23 & 44 (Exhibitors 10 years or under), & Beginner classes #89 & 96.
- No special clothing is necessary.
- Show Management reserves the right to split or combine classes.
- If you need assistance about a class, attire or procedure: contact a "Breed Mentor" listed on the ISHA website
- Coggins & Health Certificate is required for out of state horses
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- PARKING IS PROHIBITED between barns and in designated areas. Towing will be enforced.

Class Descriptions

- YOUTH classes: Under 19 years as of January 1, 2020
- OPEN classes: No age requirements
- ADULT classes: 19 years and over
- BEGINNER Classes: For riders who have been riding less than 2 years OR ride exclusively in a lesson program and do not own their own horse. BEGINNER classes allow, but do not require martingales, snaffle bits or single reins. Riders in BEGINNER classes may cross-enter other classes for which they are eligible, but all riders in BEGINNER classes must meet the criteria set forth in the first sentence. W/T riders cannot cross-enter into any W/T/C classes & W/T/C riders cannot cross-enter into any W/T class.
- *PONY class requirements: Less than 58 inches (14.2 hands) or 147 cm. Miniature Horses not allowed.
- **Restricted classes: Riders cannot enter a class which includes a canter/lope in the same division
- OPEN CARD classes #70,71,72: There is no specific exhibitor order called. Show your horse/pony between the designated times at your convenience.
- JR HORSE/PONY: 5 years and under
- RESCUE HORSE/PONY class: Defined as any horse/pony that was slaughter bound, saved from a kill pen, adopted from a Horse Rescue or saved from severe neglect. OTTBs are not considered rescues unless they meet the aforementioned criteria.
- Walk/Whoa & Back-Up class: Exhibitors will be judged at the walk, prompt complete stop-no steps, and backing up straight and halting.
- Stallions are eligible to show in any class that is not designated to mares or geldings.
- 70% Payback for most classes (see list at show)
- PAYBACK classes: Must have at least 3 entries for paybacks in \$7 classes. Must have at least 5 entries for \$10 classes. No qualifications to enter.

Fees

- Class entry Fees: All classes are \$7 except the \$50 & \$100 classes which are \$10
- No Entry fees: No entry fees for class #19, Stick Horse, #69, Obstacle Stick Horse & #82, Supreme All Breed Halter Championship
- Office fee: \$5 per horse/exhibitor combination per day
- Camping fees: \$25 per night. Electrical hook-ups available, payable to the Hoosier Horse Park. Reservations can be made the week of the show before 4PM Thursday through the HHP (812-526-6809). Prepayment by credit card required to have campsite electrical box unlocked. For late arrival without a reservation, call 317-418-6381 before 10PM Friday or Saturday.
- Stall fees: \$25/night or \$40/weekend. Stalls available at noon Friday. RESERVATIONS ARE RECOMMENDED.
- Stalls must be reserved prior to ordering shavings through the Hoosier Horse Park. Call 317-418-6381 for stall reservations and 812-526-6809 to pre-order shavings to be delivered to your stalls prior to arrival. Shavings orders need to be placed by 4 PM Thursday and pre-paid (\$7/bag)
- Tie Out fees: \$15 per horse/pony shown out of trailer in designated area per day. No overnight tie outs are allowed.
- Stall or Tie Out required for each horse/pony.
- Only 1 horse/pony or Miniature horse per stall.
